

Demolition Derby Rules August 4, 2007

Cars and Front Wheel Drive Mini Vans

All vehicles and drivers must be at the track no later than 12:30 PM for inspection, track will open at 8:00 AM. Driver's Meeting at 1:30 PM.

General Rules:

- ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL ON GROUNDS. Anyone under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drugs prior to or during the race disqualifies the vehicle and crew of the offending party.
- All drivers **MUST** be 16 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. No one under the age of 16 is allowed in pit area.
- No vulgar signs, pictures or words allowed on vehicle. This is a "family" attended event.
- All drivers are required to send in their entry fee with the form.
- Only **one** tow vehicle per derby vehicle in pit area.
- Woodstock Old Home Week or its officials are not responsible for lost or stolen items left unattended at the event.

Car and Front Wheel Drive Mini Van Rules:

Numbering: Assigned vehicle numbers must be painted on both front doors minimum of 18"x18".

Glass Removal: All glass including headlights, taillight, and all additional glass must be removed before entering the grounds. All edges of broken windows must be duct taped. DO NOT BREAK GLASS IN DOORS!

Interior Preparation: All flammable material except the dashboard and driver's seat must be removed. All airbags and airbag sensors must be disabled. Driver's door ONLY may be reinforced. It is recommended that the driver's door be reinforced. All debris must be cleared out.

Body Preparation: No welding body to the frame. It must remain stock appearance. All lights, chrome moldings, and exterior trim must be removed. NO standing or roof mounted signs. Driver's door window may not be covered with crash bars or mesh. You may cut up to a 4" hole in the firewall for the gas line and battery cables.

Doors and Trunk: Doors and trunk may be spot welded or chained, 5 on 5 patterns. Ex: Weld 5", leave 5", weld 5", and leave 5".

Hood: Hood must be chained.

Tires: Rims MUST be stock, no split rims. No fluids or chemicals in tires. Wheel weights must be removed. No solid tires or truck tires. Metal may be cut from around wheels for clearance.

Radiator: Must be in stock position and be filled with water.

Suspension: All ball joints, tire rods, control arms, and steering linkage must remain stock. Stock suspension only in vehicle, gears may be welded.

Bumpers: Bumper styles may not be interchanged must remain front on front, rear on rear. No truck or reinforced bumpers.

Battery: Battery must be located in a box securely bolted to floor; battery must be covered after inspection.

Fuel Tank: Stock fuel tanks must be removed; fuel tank must be mounted in backseat of vehicle. We recommend that you use a marine style fuel tank. All fuel lines must have leak proof fittings and run up middle of vehicle. If vehicle is equipped with electric fuel pump, must have a safety shut off switch mounted on any easy access surface and be painted red.

Frames: No welding of seams on frame or adding any metal to frame. Must be stock frame for that make and model. If the frame is broken you may use 4"x4"x3/8" thick patch one side of break only. NO other patch accepted. Over repaired frames will be considered reinforced and will result in disqualification. No trailer hitches.

Safety: Helmets and safety belts must be in good working condition and must be worn at all times while the driver is in the vehicle. Face shield or eye protection required. Neck braces are recommended. Long pants and long sleeved shirts required. Additional safety regulations may be imposed.

Note: ALL WORK MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE EVENT

Front Wheel Drive Mini Van Division ONLY:

Any 4 or 6 cylinder mini van. No diesels. No 4 wheel/all wheel drives. No "plastic" bodied mini vans such as Luminas/Transports, etc. No panel vans (the kind without rear windows.) No full size vans and no flat nosed vans. (Toyota and VW, etc.)

Demolition Derby Rules:

- **NO** two-way radio communication of any kind allowed.
- When a vehicle becomes disabled or times out, it becomes UNTOUCHABLE, an intentional hit to these vehicles will result in disqualification.
- For all vehicles in play, drivers must run aggressive until heat is over, by making a hit at least every 90 seconds.
- Intentional hits to driver's door will result in an immediate disqualification.
- Drivers must be aware of the horns, sirens and flags, which will indicate the starting and stopping of play.
- A protest fee of \$100 will be required to dispute any competing vehicle. If a DRIVER wants to protest a vehicle that they think is illegal then they must put up the \$100. If the vehicle in question is found to be illegal, then it will be disqualified and you will get your money back, however if it is legal then the driver of the vehicle in question will get \$50.
- All vehicles winning their heat may be taken aside after the heat, picked up, and inspected for any reinforcing. If any found, the vehicle is disqualified and the 2nd place vehicle will move to the finals.
- NO reckless driving in the pit area, no passengers riding in or on the vehicle.
- At any time throughout the derby, ANY vehicle can be re-inspected.
- All winning vehicles may be re-inspected prior to pay off. This means even rolling the vehicle over!
- These rules supersede any and all rules previously used. **JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL!!**

There will be a limit of 125 cars as well as 20 mini vans. Any registrations received after this date will be notified by mail. Deadline for registrations: July 20, 2007. Registration forms received after this date will be charged an additional fee of \$20 for processing.

Note: Upon receiving your entry form we will be sending you your vehicle number, your receipt and bracelets for driver and pit crew, which must be worn to get into pit area. No bracelets will be available at the gate, only in special circumstances where arrangements have been made.
